This manual is intended to give an overview of the key elements used when applying the identity.



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
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
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




1.1 CONTRUCTION




The construction of the Circus logotype is based on the shapes you see when looking through a kaleidoscope: a pattern consisting of equilateral triangles.

The logo should mainly be used in greyscale or black & white or monotone colours. There are 3 basic versions: triangle (1), steps (2) and kaleidoscope (3).







Two versions of the black & white logos have been designed, one for smaller sizes, below 100mm width and one for larger sizes, above 100mm width.


They differ in the amount of detail shown and line thickness. Please always ensure you are using the correct version according to the relevant print size.









For special usage (such as etching, laser cutting or any other application where a complexity of the logo could cause reproduction problems) a simplified solid version has been designed.

This version is available in three size: large (above 100mm width), small (below 100mm width) and extra small (below 25mm width). They differ in the thickness of the white lines and gaps.

- 2 SMALL SIMPLIFIED LOGO FOR USAGE BELOW IOOMM WIDTH

COLOUR OF PAPER

Three primary colours can be used as solid tones or in tints. Colours are specified in Pantone* (for single colour printing), CMYK (for four colour offset printing), and RGB (for web use, screen presentations and PDFs). Silver can alternatively be used as grey.


Whenever possible uncoated paper should be used for printing. The paper should be white, not cream coloured. All colours will appear slightly less intense on uncoated absorbent paper than on coated paper or on screen.



Mostra is a decorative font that matches elements of the logo. It is available in two different versions and weights.

Mostra Two Bold and Light should be used mainly for large titles.

Mostra One Bold and Light is more readble and should be used for subtitles, quotations or highlighted text.






Stempel Garamond is used for body copy. For small headings or to highlight certain passages of text the bold version can be used. Italics should be used for quotations.



GRAPHIC ELEMENTS AND IMAGES




4.1 LINES AND BORDERS



A variety of graphic lines and boarders can be used for separation, underlining or as decorative elements. They can be used in either black, silver or turquoise.

- I ZIG-ZAG LINE: THE ANGLE OF EACH ZIG AND ZAG IS 120°. THICKNESS AND SIZE ARE DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF OTHER ELEMENTS.
- 2 DOTTED LINE: TWICE THE THICKNESS OF THE ZIG-ZAG LINE.
- 3 MEANDER-LIKE BORDER: TWO LINES
 OF THE STEP LOGO WITH EXTENDED
 MIDDLE SECTION. KEEP THE ENDINGS
 THE SAME SIZE AS USED IN THE LOGO.
- 4 MEANDER-LIKE BORDER: SAME AS NUMBER 3 BUT WITH THREE INNER LINES OF THE KALEIDOSCOPE LOGO.
- 5 TRIANGLE BOARDER: CONSTRUCTED FROM THE TRIANGLE LOGO. KEEP THE TRIANGLES THE SAME SIZE AS USED IN THE LOGO.


4.2 TRIANGLES



Triangle shapes can be used as decorative elements. They can be combined with other design elements and arranged quite randomly on the page. Please see samples in section 4.4.

- I TRIANGLE TAKEN FROM THE
 KALEIDOSCOPE LOGO. ONLY TO BE
 USED IN BLACK & WHITE.
- TRIANGLE TAKEN FROM THE LINES LOGO. ONLY TO BE USED IN BLACK & WHITE.
- 3 SOLID BLACK TRIANGLES. CAN ALSO BE USED IN SHADES OF GREY.
- 4 SOLID SILVER TRIANGLES. CAN ALSO BE USED IN TINTS.
- 5 SOLID TURQUOISE (PANTONE 320 U). CAN ALSO BE USED IN TINTS.




A range of illustrations can be used in black or turquoise, as individual images or combined with triangles.









